Lovat Hose	- Wash in luke warm, soapy water – do not
	put them in the dryer (THEY WILL

Rob Roy Hose Tops	- As Lovat Hose
Spats	- Washing machine if they are washable, or
	whiten with canvas whitener if they are
	canvas
	- Blacken straps and iron flat
Flashes	- Hand wash as Lovat Hose and iron flat.
Kilt, HS	- Dry clean only after each major pde or at
	least 3 times per year;
	- Steam iron front apron & pleats.
	- Blacken straps – use liquid "scuffcote".
Brown Pouch (sporran) and strap	- Apply brown kiwi polish frequently & buff
	to a shine;
	- Same treatment for the strap, DON'T
	forget the ledges!!
White Pouch (Sporran and strap)	- Whiten frequently and buff to a shine DO
	NOT use canvas shoe whitener – use
	leather whitener only.
Horse Hair (Sporran)	- Shampoo shite horse hair in luke warm
Snr NCO's & Officers	water & rinse thoroughly (do not
	submerge). KEEP LEATHER BACKING
	DRY!!
	- Same for tassles;
	- Comb out all tangles;
All Brass and Silver Accoutrements	- Keep it hanging up and polish the brass.
All Brass and Sliver Accoutrements	- Highly polish with "Silvo" metal polish;
	 Use a toothbrush to remove all polish from cracks and crevices.

Glengarry	 Steam iron tails & glen with a pressing cloth;
	- Sponge wash with vinegar and warm
	water once in a while – 1 X Tsp vinegar to
	1 cup water, and apply with face cloth or
	sponge;
	- Put your name in it!!
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Balmoral (TOS)	- Iron a sharp crease around the perimeter
	of the hat – Trim loose thread on
	Rosette.
